Babies' body found in FLA badly beaten and discarded.

Daughter abducted and taken to another country. CO

Son disappears while walking to work. NE

6-year-old daughter abducted from ballpark in AR

Son takes a walk in Las Vegas suburb and is found murdered months later.

WARRIORS FOR THE MISSING

Due to the large volume are only able to include a small portion of the many warriors...

Jannel Rap: A singer/songwriter prior to her sister Gina's disappearance Oct 17, 2000 Jannel founded **WARRIORS FOR THE MISSING** and **GINA for Missing Persons** in honor of Gina. California.

Erin Runnion: Founding Director of **The Joyful Child Foundation**-in Memory of her 5 year old daughter, Samantha Runnion. California.

Joe Matthews: Founder of **DNA LifePrint, Inc.**.. A Criminal investigator for 35 yrs. Joe has appeared on *America's Most Wanted, Court TV, Fox News...* as an on-screen criminal analyst. He reopened and investigated the Adam Walsh investigation.

Patty Wetterling: Homemaker, prior to sons' disappearance. Her 11 year old son, Jacob, was abducted from MN 14 years ago. Patty founded **JWF Online: The Jacob Wetterling Foundation**. She is an advocate for for missing people and *ran for Congress in 2004*.

Monica Caison: **Cue Center in NC**. Her huge heart breaks down walls to find the missing and take care of their families. Monica is a finalist for "The Volvo for Life Award". North Carolina.

Abby Potash: Legal asst prior to son's disappearance. Her 8-year-old son, Sam, was abducted by her ex-husband. Sam was FOUND 8 1/2 long months later. Abby now uses her experience to help others through **Team HOPE**. Pennsylvania.

Alonzo Washington: Alonzo first heard about Precious Doe in 2001 & his mission turned into media attention for America's forgotten African American children. They are featured on his website **Omega 7**, free Omega Man trading cards, and in comic books. Kansas

Kelly Jolkowski: Office worker. Her 19-year-old son, Jason, disappeared from Omaha, NE 4 years ago. Motivated by her son's disappearance Kelly lost 200 pounds so she would have the strength for the fight and founded, **Project Jason - Assistance For Families of the Missing**.

Kym Pasqualini: NMCO was founded in 1994 by Kym who, at the age of eight, survived an attempted abduction by a knife wielding stranger. [*Nation's Missing Children Organization, Inc. \(NMCO\)*](#). Arizona.

Jodi Beyes: Harlequin Romance Author. When her former fiancé' child was abducted by her mother and taken to another country, Jodi learned about international child abduction laws & brought her home. [*Jodi Dawson*](#). Colorado.

John Paul Thornton: When JPT saw his student on an ADVO card he started painting. He has painted the faces of 100's of children. Artwork featured: on national news, TV specials and displayed from LA to DC. [*John Paul Thornton*](#). California.
